On the 27th the army concentrated at the sixth cataract and cutting loose from the last base began its final march by land and river, eight thousand British and seventeen thousand native troops, nine thousand horses, camels and mules, ten gun-boats and five steamers towing long lines of barges and sailing boats loaded with supplies.
